# Preschool & Pre-K



Bishop Leibold offers an Early Learning Program for three- and four-year-old children to best meet the educational and social needs of our families and to provide a Catholic faith experience for our youngest parishioners. These state-licensed programs are held at the West Campus and run from September to May in conjunction with the BLS calendar.



For the Preschool Program, children must be 3 years old by September 30, 2012 to participate. For the Pre-Kindergarten Program (Pre-K), children must be four years old by Sept. 30, 2012. Both programs align with the Ohio Dept. of Education's Early Learning Content Standards and are consistent with the teachings of the Catholic Church.

## Our Early Learning Program

Our Early Learning Program focuses on developing our young learners through centers such as art, dramatic play, music, library, blocks, and toys/games. Students discover how fun learning can be by using their five senses as they progress through the year with a new theme each month. Large and small group activities and outdoor play help to encourage growth socially and physically. In addition, the spiritual growth of students is developed by using Bible songs and stories, as well as daily prayer.
