The Preschool Program at Bishop Leibold School

Bishop Leibold offers an Early Learning Program for three-year-old children. To be included in the Preschool Program *children must be three years old by September 30, 2012*. (Note: Preschool students must be toilet trained to participate).

BLS Preschool for three-year-olds focuses on small group play, social skills and educational and religious instruction appropriate to this introduction to school. This program is state licensed and held at the West Campus. The program begins on Thursday, August 30, 2012 and ends on Thursday, May 30, 2013 in conjunction with the BLS school calendar.

Preschool hours are Tuesday and Thursday from 8:10 AM to 11:00 AM.

Registration and Tuition Expenses for the Preschool program:

Registration Fee: \$50.00 (non-refundable and separate from K-8 registration)

Tuition: \$810 annually (\$90 per month for nine months)

- Please note a multi-child discount for Preschool is not offered.
- Preschool families do not have to participate in the Leibold Loyalty Points Program.

The Pre-K Program at Bishop Leibold School

What is the BLS Pre- K program? BLS offers the Pre-Kindergarten program to best meet the educational needs of our families and to provide a Catholic faith experience for our youngest parishioners. This program is state licensed and held at the West Campus. It begins on Wednesday, August 29, 2012 and runs to Thursday, May 30, 2013 in conjunction with the BLS school calendar. *Children must be four years old by September 30, 2012 to participate.*

The Three-Day Program includes core Pre-K skills and standards as defined by the Ohio Department of Education. We offer music once a week, outdoor play, story time at the library and weekly Bible song and story time. Catholic religious instruction will be an important component of this program. **Capacity is 21 students.** The Three-Day Program operates on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:10 AM to 11:00 AM.

Additional Two-Day Program Enrichment (must be enrolled in the Three-Day Program). The Enrichment Program provides further exploration and development of core Pre-Kindergarten skills and religious instruction learned in the Three-Day Program. The Additional Two-Day Program operates on Tuesday and Thursday from 8:10 to 11:00 AM.

Registration and Tuition Expenses for the Pre-K Program:

Registration Fee: \$50.00 per family (non-refundable and separate from K-8 registration)

Tuition: Three-Day Program \$1215 annually (\$135 per month for nine months)

Five-Day Program \$2025 annually (\$225 per month for nine months)

- Please note a multi-child discount for Pre-K is not offered.
- Pre-K families do not have to participate in the Leibold Loyalty Points Program.

FACTS – Our New Tuition Management Company

Tuition Management Systems (TMS), our former tuition billing and management system, was bought by FACTS this past year. FACTS thus becomes the company handling all billing and questions regarding tuition payments for the 2012-13 school year.

Enrollment fees for using FACTS at the Preschool and Pre-K level are as follows:

- The Annual payment plan has no enrollment or service fee.
- There is no enrollment or service fee for the BLS Preschool or Pre-Kindergarten student.
- A family *must* complete the FACTS tuition management payment program form (even if the family is making one annual payment or benefitting from no service fee at the Preschool/Pre-K level). Each family must be enrolled into the FACTS system.

Delinquent Tuition Policy

July 1 or July 15, 2012- First tuition payment is due according to your plan.

September 1, 2012- If no payment is made by this date you will receive a letter from the principal that tuition is two months in arrears.

October 1, 2012- If no payment is made by this date a letter from the principal's office will be sent indicating that the student will be withdrawn at the end of the 1st quarter for failure to meet the tuition commitment.

Early January, 2013- Letter from the principal's office indicating the family tuition is again two months in arrears. A required meeting with the principal will be required to determine a payment plan. Failure to attend the meeting will result in the student being withdrawn for nonpayment of tuition.

Families registering for Preschool or Pre-K need to return the following by March 9th (for Guaranteed Placement):

1. The 2012 Preschool and Pre-K Registration Form
2. The FACTS tuition management payment program form
Please note: If you are accessing this registration packet on-line, you will need to call either office (434-9343 or 866-3021) to have the FACTS form mailed to you. Bar coding prevents on-line posting of this form.
3. A \$50 non-refundable Preschool/Pre-K registration fee (please note this is separate from and additional to the K-8 registration fee).
